#	CONSTITUTIONAL ROADMAP SECTION	PILLAR	RATIONALE
I	Electoral Democracy & Voting Rights	AUTONOMY	Collective self-governance requires free, fair, universally accessible elections. Without it, the people cannot exercise political autonomy.
II	Anti-Corruption, Ethics & Government Accountability	CONTRIBUTION	Corruption closes civic channels for ordinary people. Clean institutions are the prerequisite for meaningful participation.
III	Judicial Independence & Reform	CONTRIBUTION	Fair, independent courts allow citizens to hold power accountable — the most fundamental form of civic contribution.
IV	Information Integrity, Media & Press Freedom	RELATIONSHIPS	Disinformation deliberately destroys social trust and turns communities against each other. A shared epistemic commons is the foundation of relationships.
V	Human Rights & Civil Liberties	SECURITY	Protection from police violence, discrimination, and state coercion is physical security — not just justice.
VI	Economic Rights & Social Protections	SECURITY	Healthcare, housing, food, and income are material prerequisites for physical security. Without them, no other freedom is accessible.
VI I	Fiscal Policy & Economy of Care (ECGA)	PURPOSE	The Job Guarantee and full employment policy are the direct mechanisms of purpose. Government's fiscal role is to ensure meaningful work is available.
VI II	Antitrust & Market Rebalancing	PURPOSE	Monopoly eliminates diverse economic roles. Breaking concentrated power restores the conditions for meaningful participation in the economy.
IX	Data Protection & Digital Rights	AUTONOMY	The private sphere — where autonomous choices are made — is now digital. Surveillance destroys that sphere and the freedom within it.
X	Democratic Deepening & Civic Renewal	RELATIONSHIPS	Participatory institutions create the civic spaces where community bonds form. Democratic engagement is organized relationship-building.
XI	Climate Justice & Ecological Security	SECURITY	Climate destabilization is a direct threat to physical security — especially for those least responsible. Survival requires ecological stability.

Key: Pillar columns are color-coded to match the Five Pillars books image. Sections II and XI appear in two pillars each (see full documentation). The diagonal relationship between pillars and sections means that progress on any one pillar strengthens all others.
